experiences fear when they are threatened 1 web emotions have been described as consisting of a coordinated set of responses which may include verbal physiological behavioral and neural mechanisms emotions have been categorized with some relationships existing between emotions and some direct opposites existing graham differentiates emotions as functional or dysfunctional and argues all web emotions are biological states that are connected to your nervous system they are triggered by mental and physical stimuli such as thoughts and experiences emotions let you know what to do in a given situation they can help you avoid danger or web an academic study using self reporting of subjects distinguished 27 discrete emotions named as in the following list admiration adoration aesthetic appreciation amusement anger anxiety awe awkwardness boredom calmness confusion craving disgust empathetic pain entrancement excitement fear horror interest joy nostalgia relief web dec 1 2022 primary emotions such as love joy surprise anger and sadness can then be further broken down into secondary emotions love for example consists of
